

Top in net pattern

Size 36/38. Figures for size 40/42 are given in parentheses. If only one figure is given, it applies for both sizes.

Materials

5 balls Anchor Style Magicline “Stripes” col. 1404

You will need: 1 crochet hook, size 3.5 mm – 4 mm (UK 9 – 8 / US E/4 – F/5)

Tension swatch: 11 rows and 7 ch-arcs = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches), worked following CC

Instructions: For each of front and back pieces, crochet a foundation of 60 (72) ch + 1 ch to turn. For size 36/38, work following CC. For size 40/42, repeat rows 1 + 2, rows 23 + 24, and rows 40 + 41 twice each.

Finishing: Sew side seams. Work 1 row of dc along neck and armhole edges (see pattern diagram). The steps which are formed by increases and decreases can be evened out by crocheting over these edges. For each strap, crochet a length of ch, then work 1 row of dc back along the ch-chain. Block the finished top, dampen, and let dry.

Abbreviations:
CC = crochet chart
